RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE OURTOWN 56345  
LITTLE FALLS STRATEGIC FRAMEWORK 2020-2030 VISION FOR THE DECADE  
FACILITATOR'S FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS REPORT

**WHEREAS**, OurTown 56345 strategic priorities represent the vision for a future of Little Falls that is “of, for and by the people”, drawn from a community listening project that has been carefully constructed to identify what is most broadly important to residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the priorities identified by this process are the result of nearly 100 narrative surveys, 113 individuals interviews, 19 focus groups, 3 City wide open house meetings, and 408 online surveys, all of which were made possible by over 1,200 volunteer hours from community members; and

**WHEREAS**, the plan aims to improve the quality of life for all citizens in Little Falls and to do so based on the strategic priorities identified “as relevant” by residents; and

**WHEREAS**, a broad survey of stakeholders from the business community, civic organizations, education leaders, conservation experts, creative, and faith-based community members who came together to help identify local priorities, values, and existing assets.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Little Falls hereby accepts and approves the “OurTown 56345 Little Falls Strategic Framework 2020-2030 Vision for the Decade, Facilitator’s Final Recommendations” report dated July 2020, for continued development, community engagement and implementation; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that as these strategic priorities were determined by the community itself, any resident or group may propose projects that align with said priorities within the Final Report.
